
Cosplay Guidelines

- Your participation in this event means that you agree to comply with the Cosplay Guidelines.
- Costumes must be family-friendly. Costumes that are overly revealing, gory, or deemed inappropriate or offensive by staff are not permitted.
- For safety, footwear must be worn at all times, even if a character is typically barefoot. Socks alone are not proper footwear.
- Wheeled vehicles, with the exception of mobility devices, are not permitted within the building. This includes skateboards, scooters, bicycles, etc.
- Uniforms which are too realistic are not permitted. You should not be confused with official law enforcement, military personnel, or security staff.
- Any make-up must be properly sealed so that it does not rub off with casual contact or make a mess.
- Masks are allowed, but must be removable at a staff member's request.
- For safety, oversized costumes greater than two feet from any side are not permitted indoors.
- If you want someone's photo, be polite and ask first. Photos should not be taken in high traffic areas and no money may be exchanged in return for pictures
- The Citrus County Library System reserves the right to refuse entry or ask any person to change or leave at any time due to an inappropriate costume.
- Remember: Cosplay is not consent; please treat others with respect. Failure to adhere to the Citrus Libraries Code of Conduct will result in an immediate request to leave the premises.

Prop Check Guidelines

- Your participation in this event means that you agree to comply with the Prop Check Guidelines.
- For your own safety and the safety of everyone at the event, staff has the absolute and immediate discretion and right to inspect your costumes, prop weapons, and any other item you bring to the event.
- We may temporarily or permanently remove any attendee in our sole and absolute discretion at any time for violating the Prop Check Guidelines.
- The Citrus County Library System reserves the right to modify and/or update the guidelines at any time in their sole discretion and without prior notice.
- **Real weapons are not permitted, including but not limited to:**
 - Firearms, knives, curios, relic antique firearms, throwing stars, or any form of ammunition.
- Your prop weapon cannot be more than 7 feet in any direction or weigh more than 15 pounds.
- Everyday items such as umbrellas or walking sticks/canes are permitted within the event and subject to inspection upon entry.
- Lightweight plastic or foam bats, paddles, and clubs are permitted.
